
A Skype Visit with Award-Winning Author Barbara Techel and her Special Dog Frankie, the Walk 'N Roll Dog

Introduction

Hello and welcome to the information to read before a visit from children's author, or if you are considering a visit with **Barbara Techel** and her **special dog on wheels, Frankie**. Whether you are having us visit in person and dog or via Skype (or other type of video conferencing), this information will be of help in planning your event.

About Barbara Techel

Barbara Techel never intended to be a children's author. But sometimes life has a way of handing us an opportunity, and if we are open to the blessing being presented, it could have a positive effect on our life.

That is exactly what happened to Barbara. Her journey since 2005 has been an incredible one. Losing her chocolate lab, Cassie Jo to bone cancer in July of 2005 set Barbara on a spiritual journey. After some intense coaching with a life coach, she decided to follow her heart and write about what she loves most; dogs and animals. She landed her first writing job with her local paper, the Depot Dispatch and had her own column for two years called, *For the Love of Animals*. Expanding upon her love of animals, she brought home a English yellow lab Christmas 2005 and began training her as a therapy dog and hoped to write about their experiences.

Just as life was cruising along and Barbara was finding her new purpose in life, there was a fork in the road. Frankie, her 6-year old miniature dachshund, suffered a fall while staying at a kennel. That fall resulted in emergency surgery giving Frankie a 10-30% chance of walking again. Barbara was devastated, put her dream of being a therapy dog team with Kylie on hold, and attended to the many nursing home care needs of Frankie.

Frankie's road was mixed with ups and downs and after three months of no signs of walking, Barbara had her custom-fitted for a doggie wheelchair. This is where an opportunity was presented and Barbara realized the blessing to why this had happened to her and Frankie.

As Barbara and Frankie shopped at their local Farmer's Market the summer Frankie began using her wheelchair, they were met with much compassion and interest in the "dog with tires." Children loved seeing Frankie in her wheels and wanted to know why she had a wheelchair. Barbara realized she was meant to write Frankie's story to help children see their own challenges in a positive way. Eleven months later *Frankie, the Walk 'N Roll Dog* story book was published.

Visits to schools revealed the next blessing in Barbara and Frankie's journey. One such visit a teacher commented on how well behaved Frankie is with children. She encouraged Barbara and Frankie to become a therapy dog team. In 2008 Barbara and Frankie began their volunteer work and several times a month split their time between visiting a senior assisted living facility, a hospice community and their local hospital. From visits at the senior assisted living called, Libby's House, Barbara was inspired to write, *Frankie, the Walk 'N Roll Therapy Dog Visits Libby's House* which was published in 2010.

Barbara continues her writing as a contributing writer for her local paper, as well as her blogs, online directories and entering writing contests. In 2005 her story, "Cassie and Frankie Inspire A Writer" won honorable mention and in 2009 her story, "The Blessing of a Wheelchair-Bound Dachshund" won 2nd place. Both contests were sponsored by best selling authors, Linda and Allen Anderson of Angel Animals Network.

Frankie's story featured in *Every Dog has a Gift* by Rachel McPherson published by Tarcher/ Penguin Publishing March 2010, *Dogs and the Women Who Love Them* by Linda and Allen Anderson published by New World Library Fall 2010 and bestselling magazine, *Woman's World* 2010.

When not writing, doing school visits, volunteer therapy dog work, or helping out in her husband John's construction business, Barbara enjoys spending quiet time with her husband of 25-years, with Frankie and Kylie close by. It is in those moments that she gives her deepest thanks to God for all her many, many blessings.

Barbara & Frankie's books

I like to include Frankie as co-author, because if not for her, I may have never written children's books!

Our books are non-fiction and aimed at 7-11 year olds, but I have many younger children that enjoy having the story read to them (time and time again!), as well as many young adults and adults who enjoy our books, as well as seeing our presentation.

Frankie, the Walk 'N Roll Dog is the true, inspirational story how Frankie began her life walking like a regular dog, until a spinal injury leaves her paralyzed. After months of therapy she is custom-fitted for a doggie wheelchair. Her life since then is hard to keep up with because she does not see her disability as anything that should hold her back, but lives life to the fullest.

Frankie, the Walk 'N Roll Therapy Dog Visits Libby's House is the second book in the Frankie series. Frankie's visits as a therapy dog to Libby's House, a senior assisted living, is shared from Frankie's point of view of the residents she meets and befriends. Many have Alzheimer's or dementia and through Frankie's example, she teaches children that patience, listening and understanding is what will lead to what matters most, which is love.

Frankie, the Walk 'N Roll Activity Book is a 28-page companion book to either of Frankie's books to further expand on Frankie's lessons of being positive and giving back to the world despite our challenges.

It is a good idea to display both story books in the library or classroom before our scheduled Skype visit. We offer special school pricing for our books, so please contact us at joyful-paws@yahoo.com or barbtechel@verizon.net to purchase copies for your school.

Book Orders for our visit via Skype: Please send book order form home two weeks in advance with a due date due one week after our visit. On that due date please email me the names of all students who wish to have a personally signed copy. I will then ship the books directly to your school and will invoice you for total number of books sold, plus shipping. Books are mailed priority and insured to ensure they arrived in a timely and safe manner. **Book order form is included in this ebook. PLEASE NOTE IT IS TWO PAGES: Page 9 & 10.**

Note: Part of our mission is to help other disabled animals, so we do donate a portion of all book proceeds to various disabled animal charities.

Our Needs When Visiting Virtually Via Skype

(or other video conferencing determined ahead of time)

Our needs are really going to be based upon what your school has available for set up. Ideally you want to project Frankie and me onto one screen and have a separate screen that will show our power point slides. If you are only able to have one screen then you will need to flip back and forth between my presentation and the slides.

Once you book a virtual visit with us we will send you a link that will contain our power point slides, as well as a short video I will have you show during my presentation, which shows how well Frankie can roll along in her wheels. This is a big hit with the children! As I give my talk, I will say, "next slide" so having someone designated ahead of time that will do this will work great.

Please email us your Skype name or if using another video conferencing service we will need that information.

We prefer no more than 2 classrooms (with 60 or less children) taking part in the Skype visit. This is to help engage the children and keep the energy going of the visit.

Speaking fee will be invoiced directly to your school and due day of my visit or can be lumped together with book sales.

Outline of Our Presentation

- Introduction of Frankie, type of dog she is, how she could walk like a regular dog for six years, sharing slides via power point with photos of Frankie before and after her paralysis, as well as her life in photos of how she lives a quality and full life in a doggie wheelchair.
- Explanation of her injury that led to paralysis and how she now rolls in her wheelchair. Demonstration of how I help her go to the bathroom and how she gets in and out of her wheelchair. Also a demo or video showing how good Frankie can roll along in her wheels!

• Q & A

Teaches children so many valuable lessons:

- The importance of caring for their own animals
- Compassion and not judging others, human or animal
- Responsibility of having a pet and caring for them even when sick or injured
- Helps children understand if they choose to be positive despite their own challenges how much easier their lives will be
- Frankie's work as a therapy dog, despite her challenges helps children see we can each give back to our own communities in our own, unique way.

Payment

Virtual Visit payment is due day of our visit or depending on book sales due date I can invoice everything together. If we include speaking fee, plus book sales and shipping, I will invoice your school directly and books will be shipped once payment is received.

When to Book

Our calendar fills quickly, so the sooner we can secure a date, the better. Please keep in mind that we also only schedule visits for twice weekly. Booking at least one month out is best to build excitement for our visit and plan for the event.

Cancellations

To date, knock on wood, I have not had to cancel. But if due to illness with me or Frankie or an emergency and I would have to cancel I will do my best to reschedule as soon as possible.

If you or I have to cancel the visit, let's agree to try and give as much notice as possible. Though I do understand last minute problems can arise.

Tips to Ensure a Successful Skype Visit

- Please let the children know Frankie and I will be visiting via Skype. This builds excitement and anticipation of our visit. It's a good idea to have our books displayed in the school library so the children can read about Frankie ahead of time. Post bio (included in this ebook in your school or classroom(s).
- In fact why not get everyone involved and read the story to the students. You can visit our website, www.joyfulpaws.com and watch Frankie's inspirational video.
