
A Visit with Award-Winning Author Barbara Techel and her Special Dog Frankie the Walk 'N Roll Dog


Frankie the Walk 'N Roll Therapy Dog Visits Libby's House

Frankie's visits as a therapy dog to Libby's House, a senior assisted living, is shared from Frankie's point of view of the residents she meets and befriends. Many have Alzheimer's or dementia and through Frankie's example, she teaches children that patience, listening and understanding is what will lead to what matters most, which is love.

Our Needs When We Visit Via Skype

Audiences: Typically we speak to K through 4th grade students. We have also addressed 5th and 6th graders also as the message about challenges and disabilities is a message for a universal audience. We can discuss your needs and see how we can best meet them.

Needs are based upon what your school or organization has available for set up. Ideally, it is best to project Frankie and me onto one screen and have a separate screen that will show our Power Point slides and video. If you are only able to have one screen then you will need to flip back and fourth between my presentation and slides.

Once you book a virtual visit with us we will send you a link that will contain our Power Point slides, as well as a short video I will have you show which shows how Frankie walks in her wheelchair. This is a big hit with the children! As I give my talk, I will ask need someone to be the designated person so as I say, "next slide" you can advance to next slide.

We have found that to Skype it is most beneficial for the children if we keep it to no more than 2 classrooms totaling 60 children or less. This helps to keep the kids engaged and helps keep the energy of the visit going. It is more interactive as well, as with the help of the teachers I am able to call on students if I ask a question.

It is a wonderful idea to get the kids involved with the whole experience of learning how a Skype visit is set up. You can assign co-hosts to welcome the author to the Skype call as well as co-hosts to thank the author at the end of the Skype call. Have fun with it and the kids will learn so much more.

Book orders for our visit via Skype: Please send book order form (included in back of this ebook, pages 17 & 18) home two weeks in advance of our Skype visit. Any books sold you will need to email me quantity and names to personalize books to. We will then invoice your school for total number of books sold. We will handle shipping costs if in the United States. Out of US we will discuss rate.

Part of our mission is to help special needs animals so a portion of book proceeds is donated to various disabled animal charities and organizations.

PAYMENT

Payment is due one week before my scheduled Skype visit. We can invoice you via Paypal or invoice your school directly. Please let me know when you book your visit how you would like to pay so we know how to bill you.

Any book orders will be collected by your school and names to personalize books will need to be emailed to me. **Please note: Books will be shipped once payment has been received.**

When to book

Our calendar does fill quickly, so the sooner you schedule a date, the better. Booking one month in advance is best to build excitement for our visit and plan the event.

Cancellations

Due to unforeseen illness of myself or Frankie, or an emergency, we would have to postpone the visit and re-schedule.

Tips to Ensure a Successful Skype Visit

- Please let the students know Frankie and I will be visiting via Skype. This build's excitement and anticipation of our visit. It's a good idea to have our books displayed in the school library so the students can read about Frankie ahead of time.
- In fact why not get everyone involved and read the story to the students. You can visit our website and watch Frankie's inspirational video. You can also visit Frankie's blog to learn about her adventures. The more you involve the students the more likely they are to take to heart the many valuable lessons Frankie has to share. - Post Frankie's poster in library or classroom(s) to remind kids of the exciting visit coming up. There is also a bio of Barbara Techel and Frankie that can be posted in the teacher's lounge if you'd like.
- Make copies of book marks included in this ebook to hand out to each child as a
- remembrance of our visit.

Prior to Skype Visit:

- Book Skype visit and let us know your preference of payment whether we invoice your school via PayPal or invoice you directly with check being mailed to us. Payment is due no later than one week prior to our Skype visit.
- E-mail Skype name you will be using to me at joyfulpaws@yahoo.com. If you wish to do a test run, please let me know a time and date that would work to test the connection prior to our actual Skype visit day.
- Please make sure you are able to open and view Power Point, as well as video. If not, we will need to plan accordingly.
- Once visit is booked we will send link to bonus materials, as well as Power Point and video which will be used day of Skype call.
- Send book order form home two weeks before the Skype visit.
- Have students think of questions they'd like to ask for the Q & A.

Day of Skype Visit:

- Last minute book orders collected.
- Distribute book marks and make copies of free downloadable materials for students.

After Day of Visit:

- Email book order quantities and names to personalize in books

Presentation Outline

I offer a presentation that last approximately 30 minutes and a presentation that lasts approximately 40 minutes with time for Q & A at the end of each. Each presentation includes a PowerPoint of slides.

Outline for 30 minute (approx) presentation (best for K-2 or any grade if you won't want the 40 minute presentation)

- ~Discussion of dachshund breed
- ~Discussion of how Frankie's life was for the first six years of her life without her wheelchair
- ~Discussion of Frankie's spinal injury, how it happened, showing a diagram of a dachshund spine explaining how dogs and people spines are similar in how they work
- ~Discussion of the accident that caused Frankie's injury by doing a selected reading from *Frankie the Walk 'N Roll Dog*.
- ~Demonstration of Frankie's wheelchair. Student volunteer involvement.
- ~Discussion of how I help Frankie go to the bathroom because of her paralysis.
- ~Demonstration of physical therapy I did for Frankie. Student volunteer involvement.
- ~Discussion about challenges, attitude & giving back to society incorporating Frankie's book *Frankie the Walk 'N Roll Therapy Dog Visits Libby's House*.
- ~Discussion of Frankie's therapy dog work at Libby's House
- ~Discussion/photos of Frankie after her injury living life to the fullest
- ~Discussion of how Frankie never felt sorry for herself and how she persevered.
- ~Discussion about challenges and how they are part of life and help us to learn and grow into better people and end with Frankie's motto: "Always be positive, make a difference, and keep on rolling!"
